**Facts Found:** 1. C did not come to the hearing because racing was still in progress.

- 2. SI Appendix I paragraph 2 states that the Class Flag for TP52 Division shall be Numeral Pennant 2.
- 3. In Race 1, the race committee displayed Numeral Pennant 1 as the Class Flag for TP52 Division.
- 4. On display of Numeral Pennant 1, C did not commence starting manoeuvres, and as a result had a poor start.
- 5. C placed last in Race 1.
- 6. C placed 2 and 3 in Races 2 and 3.

**Conclusions:** 1. The protest committee decided to hear the request in the absence of C

in accordance with rule 63.3(  $\ensuremath{\text{b}}$  ). If C requests within the time

prescribed in SI 12.3 the hearing may be reopened.

2. Displaying Numeral Pennant 1 as the Class Flag for TP52 Division was an

improper action by the race committee.

3. C's score in Race 1 was made significantly worse by the improper action

of the race committee through no fault of her own. C is entitled to

redress under rule 62.
