Case Introduction:

At the start Windward Boat

Procedural Matters:

Two members of the PC were sailing in other divisions and no Conflict or objections Protest is valid, both parties hailed each other and flew a flag

Facts found:

- Khaleesi on port tack, tacked to leeward of Anarchy into an overlap to Leeward of Anarchy at approx.
 45 seconds from the start
- 2. Anarchy established an overlap on KD1 from clear astern 30 seconds before the start
- 3. As the boats got closer to the Start Line at around 15 seconds before the start, Khaleesi was leeward boat with Anarchy to windward and KD1 to windward of that
- 4. Anarchy was close to Khaleesi but keeping clear and the boats were compressing
- 5. Shortly before the start, KD1 altered course to windward and their stern hit the side of Anarchy
- 6. KD1 did a 360 turn in acknowledgement of the infringement
- 7. It was not reasonably possible for Anarchy to avoid the collision
- 8. Anarchy has damage amidships that did not effect the ability of Anarchy to continue in the race but will need to be repaired after the series
- 9. KD1 had damage to the stern port side that is only minor

Conclusion & Rules: 11, 14, 15

- 1. When Anarchy established its leeward overlap it gave KD1 room to keep clear
- 2. KD1 as Windward boat failed to keep clear of Anarchy
- 3. KD1 did a 360 turn in acknowledgement of the infringement
