5 Description of Windward-Leeward Courses





- 5.2 The approx. magnetic bearing to the first mark may be displayed from the Race Committee Vessel prior to the start.
- For all W/L courses, boats shall sail between the Gate marks from the direction of the previous mark. If only one Gate mark is set, boats shall round the mark to port.
- 5.4 The course will not be changed after the start.
- 5.5 At the discretion of the race committee, Mark 1 or 2 may not be laid.

5 The Start

Boats starting later than 5 minutes after her starting signal will be scored did not start (DNS). This changes RRS A4.1.

6 The Finish

- 6.1 The finishing line will be between a staff displaying a blue flag on the committee boat and the course side of the finishing mark.
- When a finish mark with a black & white chequered band is laid on the starboard side of the race committee vessel, boats shall finish by passing the committee vessel to starboard and the B&W finish mark to port.
- 6.3 When a finish mark with a black & white chequered band is not laid on the starboard side of the race committee vessel, boats shall finish by passing the committee vessel to port and the yellow start mark to starboard.

6 Time Limit

The time limit will be 90 minutes from the Class starting signal.
